THE FOUR MINISTERS STRESS ON A LOCAL PURCHASING POLICY AS PART OF THE STATE FOOD SERVICES IN RESPONSE TO THE FARMERS CLAIMS

"Pursuant to the Support Plan for breeding presented Wednesday, July 22, Bernard Cazeneuve (Minister of Interior), Stéphane LE FOLL (Minister of Agriculture and Forests and government spokesman), Emmanuel Macron (Minister of Economy) and Marylise Lebranchu (Minister of Decentralisation and Public Service) wrote this Tuesday, July 28, prefects requesting them to ensure that food services State be attentive to the implementation of this priority. This is possible, in accordance with the law of public procurement and Community rules. The publication of a new ordinance on public procurement presented by the Cabinet on July 22 by Emmanuel Macron and will enter into force by the end of the year will systemise the development of a public procurement policy highlighting production and local know-how.

The ""Ministers also asked the prefects to sensitise local authorities to these possibilities opened by the procurement law.
